My guess is that we will receive an appointment to the U17 Girls and U15 Girls at University of Manitoba in August as well as an appointment to the Western Canada Games (U15) in Kamloops. U17 will be a 3 person mechanics appointment and the U15’s are two person.</p> <p>Hoopla – Nominations request have been sent out for the 27 officials assigned to Hoopla in Moose Jaw, March 24 – 26, 2011. I will meet with SHSAA to discuss the final list in February.</p> <p>Officials Development – SHSAA hosted a tournament in Regina for 2A Girls and 4A Boys and 5 officials from the rural communities took part.
