1. Y N A violation is committed for illegally returning the ball to the backcourt. Is the resulting throw in always made in the front court?
2. Y N On an Unsportsmanlike foul must the person who was fouled shoot the resulting free throws?
3. Y N A3 is awarded two free throws as the result of an Unsportsmanlike foul and cannot shoot them owing to injury. Must A3's substitute shoot the free throws?
4. Y N Coach B receives a technical foul in the 3rd quarter. May any eligible player from Team A shoot the free throws?
5. Y N A double foul is called with Team A in possession of the ball. Is the shot clock ever reset in this situation?
6. Y N Two free throws are awarded to B3. Are substitutes allowed between the two free throws by B3?
7. Y N B3 taps the opening jump out of bounds. A3 is awarded the throw in and accidentally passes it in to B1. Does Team B get the next alternating possession?
8. Y N A1 dives and steals a pass and subsequently slides 20 feet on her back before coming to a rest. Is this traveling?
9. Y N Team A has 2 seconds left on the shot clock and is awarded a throw in from their front court. A1 deliberately throws the ball and hits the rim of the basket they are shooting at. Should the shot clock be reset when the throw in hits the rim?
10. Y N Team A has 2 seconds on the shot clock and A1 attempts to pass the ball to A2. The ball hits B2 in the head and hits the underside of the rim. Should the shot clock be reset when the ball hits the rim?
11. Y N Dribbler A1 is advancing toward the frontcourt. In an effort to go around defender B1, A1 who now has both feet in the frontcourt, dribbles the ball behind his back. The ball hits the back of his leg and bounces in the backcourt where A2 retrieves the ball. Is this a legal play?
12. Y N There is a violation before the jump ball is tapped. Can any team substitute at this time?
13. Y N Dribbler A1 is on a fast break when B1 fouls A1 from the side or behind. The official calls a foul. Must the official call an Unsportsmanlike foul always in this case?
14. Y N Team A has the ball in the front court with 5 seconds left on the shot clock when A1 attempts a pass and B1 intentionally kicks the ball. Should Team A get a throw in with 24 seconds on the shot clock?
15. Y N Team A has the ball in the front court with 5 seconds left on the shot clock when A1 attempts a pass and B1 intentionally taps the ball out of bounds. Should Team A get a throw in with 14 seconds on the shot clock?
