

## FIBA rules

### Refresher 2003-2004

1. With Team A in control of the ball, A4 is tied up by B4 and a held ball is called. The alternating possession arrow favours Team A. Shall the shot clock be reset?
2. A4's try for goal is in the air when the 30-second clock expires. The ball strikes the ring but is unsuccessful. Shall the official blow the whistle for a shot clock violation and award a throw-in to Team B?
3. A4 is holding the ball in his/her backcourt and is closely guarded by B4 for 5 seconds. Is this a closely guarded situation resulting in a violation charged against A4 ?
4. Team control ends when the ball has left a player's hand(s) on a pass. Is this correct ?
5. Team A is entitled to a throw-in by virtue of the alternating process. Before the throw-in by Team A, a foul is called on Team A. Shall the next alternating possession still favour Team A ?
6. Team A is awarded 2 free throws plus possession as a result of an unsporting foul . The officials erroneously allow players to take positions along the free throw lane. After the second unsuccessful throw, the ball is rebounded by B4 who advances the ball and scores a field goal. The error is now discovered. Is the error correctable ?
7. With 1:58 to play in the game, Team A scores and the game clock is stopped. Substitute B6 who has reported to the scorer's table wishes to substitute. Should B6 be allowed to enter the game?
8. A4 passes to A5. A5 and B5 jump and simultaneously grab the pass. They both return to the floor with a firm hold on the ball and with A5 having one foot touching the side line. The official calls a jump ball and decides that play will resume according to the alternating process. Is the official correct?
9. B4 commits an unsportsmanlike foul on A5. Before the ball becomes live for A5's first free throw, A6 is called for a technical foul. The officials rule that the two penalties cancel each other and that play should resume with the possession arrow. Are the officials correct?
10. Team A is awarded two free throws. After the ball is handed to the free thrower for the final free throw, A5 fills a vacant lane space. The official immediately calls a lane violation on A5 and awards the ball to Team B. Is the official correct?
11. Players A4 and B4 commit a double foul while neither team is in control of the ball. Shall play resume with a jump ball between A4 and B4?
12. Players A4 and B4 commit a double foul while Team B is in control of the ball. Shall the shot clock be reset?
13. During an interval of play, A4 and A5 are each charged with a technical foul. The officials instruct the scorer to count the fouls as player fouls leading to the disqualification of A4 and A5, and as Team A's fouls leading to the free throw penalty in the next period. Are the officials correct?
14. On a final free throw, B4 commits a lane violation and then free thrower A4 violates. The officials call a double violation and award a throw-in according to the alternating possession rule. Is this correct?
15. During the third quarter Team A has already used one of its time-outs. May Team A use either or both of the remaining time-outs during the third quarter?
